Budget Reduction Plan for 2012-13	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Our current budget was built on a set amount of student enrollment; this school year we have flat-lined and have had 0% growth as an entire district, so we have had less money coming in this year than we thought. The district has had to dip into the rainy-day fund. • Edujobs has helped some – but it is gone for next year. • There will be a 3.5 million dollar shortage for next year. District is currently in the processing of creating the budget. Our #1 goal is to save the programs and staff. Positions may be absorbed through attrition, spending will be very frugal, looking at going to a tiered bussing system for a huge savings. MISD is in great shape compared to some districts around us. Dr. Allen is hosting public meetings regarding the budget reduction on February 8th and 9th. 	
Tolerance & Sensitivity/Decrease of Inappropriate Behaviors/Safe and Civil Schools (G1:H and G3:P)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Brian Vasek informed the committee that we will be doing a survey with students, parents and faculty about the safety of the school. • The anti-bullying and student safety and wellness programs/information were reviewed on the MMS website and it was explained that parents and students can report anonymously. All of the positive signs through-out MMS were mentioned as well as the “WEIRD” rally that was held and the “PAUSE”-positive, accepting, understanding, safe and encouraging – theme was discussed. • Mr. Vasek also reported on the 100+ cameras installed at MMS and how helpful they have been as a deterrent of negative behavior and an important tool when investigating any negative behavior. • MMS is working at putting practices into place to help the students understand right from wrong 	Brian Vasek

We will be participating in “Walk Across Texas” soon. • Kyle Citrano asked if all students are required to participate PE/team sports: Mrs. Ford stated that it is required for all 7th graders to take a PE credit and it is optional for 8th graders; Mrs. Allison stated that 60-80% of MISD students are involved in athletics and that we will be getting course interest from incoming 7th graders to plan accordingly for next year.
