

Prekindergarten Parent Information

Midway ISD offers PreK programs at five of our six elementary campuses: Castleman Creek, Hewitt, South Bosque, Spring Valley, and Woodway. Students who qualify for PreK services from Speegleville Elementary will attend the PreK program at South Bosque Elementary.

Prekindergarten Eligibility:

To be eligible for enrollment in the prekindergarten program, a child must be at least 4 years of age on or before September 1 and must be:

1. Unable to speak and comprehend the English language
2. From a family whose income, according to standards set by the State Board of Education, is at or below the subsistence level
3. Is a child of a parent in the armed services on active duty or of a parent who has lost his or her life during duty
4. Is a homeless child
5. Is a child who is, or ever has been, in the conservatorship of the Department of Family and Protective Services following an adversary hearing

The following information is necessary to complete registration:

1. Birth certificate
2. Immunization records (requirements may be obtained from school office)
3. Social security card
4. Proof of Midway residency (must be: water bill, gas bill, electric bill, lease agreement or purchase contract)

Only certain cases:

5. Military eligibility (see campus counselor for options)
