### 1. **MHS-Ready, Set, Teach class**

- a. Vanessa Dulock-MHS teacher and MHS students
  - i. Students from the Ready, Set, Teach class at the HS shared a lesson they taught to teachers during PLC time. The lesson was based on characteristics of resilient people. The students stated that teachers loved it and felt the lessons were impactful.

### 2. **Community Involvement**

- a. Multicultural Fair on May 20th, Brooke Baker
  - i. The HS is hosting a multicultural fair for students on April 21st. The district-wide event will be changed to a picnic at the park with a community resource fair. A district-wide multicultural fair will be held in the Fall.

- a. School Health Services Update-Dee Ann Kleypas, Coordinator of Health Services, SHAC Co-Chair
  - i. DeeAnn reported that things have been calmer for the nurses with few COVID and flu cases. Dr. Popejoy said doctors have seen low cases of flu as well. For future planning, the health team is looking into a Midway Wellness Center. Telehealth services will continue to be provided next year.



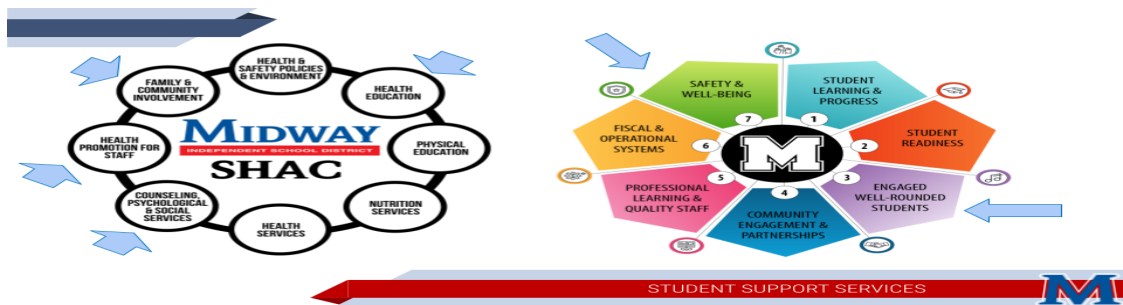
#### 4. Health Education

- a. Sex Education, Health TEKS and SHAC-Anne-Marie Zellers, Coordinator for Student Support Services, SHAC Co-Chair
  - i. Timeline of Health TEKS and Recommendation Process-Anne-Marie provided a copy of the timeline of events that have happened from Sept-April to review health TEKS and sex-education curriculum options.
- b. *Choosing the Best* and *Big Decisions*- which one will we recommend to the Board at the May 17th meeting?
  - i. After reviewing the sex education curriculum options, “Big Decisions” and “Choosing the Best” were finalists. “Choosing the Best” was the favored curriculum because it offers options to purchase age-appropriate lessons for 6-8th grade and HS students, character traits are attached to each lesson, training for teachers is provided, and lessons are available online and in print. Beginning with the 2022-2023 school year, the sex education curriculum will be taught in 6th-8th grade science courses in Spring rather than in the Panther Pathways and AVID classes.
  - ii. After discussion and quick review of the two curriculums, “Choosing the Best” and “Big Decisions”, Dr. Jeanie Johnson asked that all SHAC members stand for a vote. A motion was made by Dr. Kiraly to recommend “Choosing the Best” sex education curriculum to the Board on May 17th, Jess Wheeler seconded the motion. Dr. Johnson asked all in favor of recommending “Choosing the Best” to say “Aye” and all opposed to say “No”. All members responded in favor of recommending “Choosing the Best”; therefore, the motion passes and the recommendation is adopted. The recommendation from SHAC will be presented to the Board at the May 17th, regular meeting.
  - iii. Discuss Template of Recommendation to the Board-AZ will send by email the letter that will go to the Board on May 17th with SHACs recommendation.



- c. Local County Statistics-Emily Green, Public Health Education Specialist–Waco-McLennan County Public Health District- Emily was unable to attend the meeting, so she sent an email with local McLennan County pregnancy and STD statistics.

5. **Community Based Accountability System (CBAS)**-Dr. Johnson, Assistant Superintendent of Administrative Services- Dr. Jeanie Johnson discussed the new accountability system for Midway. SHAC members and visitors were divided into groups according to the seven pillars. Each group made a list of what is important to see as parents and community members in each measured area. A quick discussion followed the group activity.
