We Miss You When You Miss School!

When students are not in school, regardless of the reason, research shows:

- Chronic absences in elementary are early warning signs of failing courses in middle and high school.
- Chronic absences in early grades are linked to higher suspension and drop-out rates.
- Absences can affect the whole classroom if the teacher has to slow down learning to help children catch up.

IT'S THE
LAW!

1. Compulsory Attendance

All children of school age are required to be in school. This includes Pre-K and Kindergarten.

2. Minimum Attendance for Credit

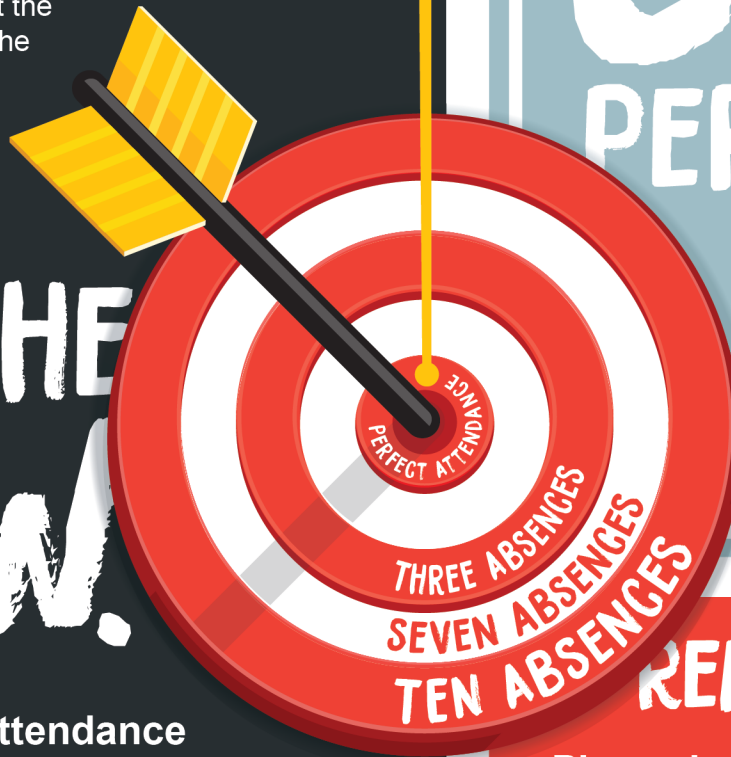
Students must have 90% attendance in each class to receive credit or promotion to the next grade level.

3. Truancy Prevention Measures

By Texas law, letters must be sent to notify parents when students have 3, 7, and 10 **unexcused** absences. At 10 **unexcused** absences, you could be eligible for court.

PERCENT

By law, every student, must attend at least 90% of the days classes are offered.



REMINDER:

Please be aware that no more than three parent notes per semester will be considered for excused absences.
