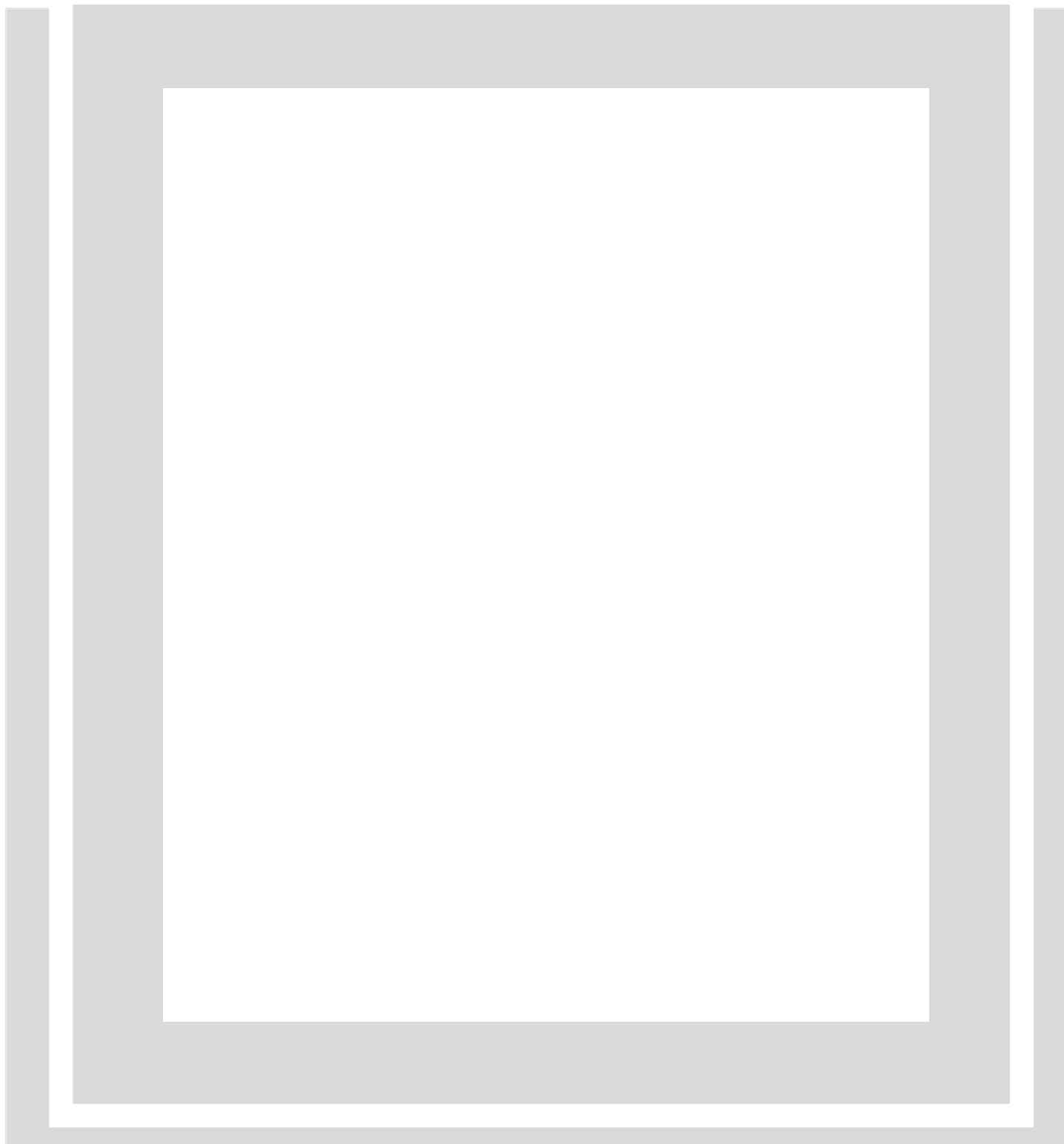

This is an MHS PTA Fundraiser. Your support helps MHS PTA provide student scholarships, teacher appreciation events, Sr. Picnic, Promenade, After Prom, & many other projects.

PARTICIPATION

MHS PTA is selling the exclusive rights for the Seniors of the Class of 2023 to reserve a parking space for their exclusive use for the 2022-2023 school year. This is only open to students who are considered Seniors by the MHS Administration by the beginning of the first semester of the 2022-23 school year.

The cost of each of these parking spaces is \$75. In addition to the \$75 fee for reserving the parking space, students will need to purchase an MHS parking sticker for the lot of their reserved space as well as any supplies necessary to paint your reserved parking space.

All seniors wishing to reserve a Senior Parking Space must complete the following steps:

1. Go to the MHS PTA Web page and download and print the 22-23 Senior parking space packet.
2. Read the entire packet, fill out and sign the parking space agreement.
3. Have a parent or legal guardian read the packet and sign the parking space agreement.
4. Bring the signed waiver and contract to one of the Senior Parking Space Sales.
5. Pay the \$75 reservation fee to MHS PTA in exact cash, credit card, or a parent/guardian check. *If paying by check, please show a driver's license.*
6. Turn in your signed documents and select your parking space.
7. Follow the instructions for "Painting" your senior parking space.
8. Students must purchase a parking sticker in a lot of their space within the first 2 weeks of school.

Senior Parking Space Sale Dates:

Tuesday, May 24th, 6PM - 8PM **Selling only NO PAINTING**

Sunday, June 5th, 6-8PM. **Sales and First Painting Night**

Thursday, June 16th, 7-9PM **Sales and painting night***

Thursday, July 21st, 7-8PM **Sales**, 7-10PM **Paint***

Sunday, August 14th, 7-8PM **Sales**, 6:30-10pm **Paint***

*These dates are subject to change based on summer schedules.

Sales on 5/24/2022 will be held by the "snake" sidewalk in the back of MHS by the parking lot starting at 6PM. Students will be asked to leave if they arrive before 4PM. Students may not save places in line for friends or leave items in line to hold their spot. **ONE PARKING SPOT PER PERSON IN LINE.**

2023 Senior spaces are available in the white lot, the blue lot and a very limited number in the red lot. MHS Parking Spaces will be sold on a first come first served basis. The first students to arrive at the sale will be able to choose spaces on the first row of each Senior parking section. When the first row has been filled, we will open the next row for selection.

Students may only purchase one space. If students want to park beside a friend or beside a group, please come together to the Senior Parking Space sale. If a senior is not able to attend one of the senior parking lot sales, a parent or guardian may attend to purchase a parking space on the student's behalf.

Once a Senior Parking Space has been reserved, students will not be able switch spaces. There are varying widths, blemishes, rough spots and some utility access points in some of the available parking spaces. Some parking spaces were painted by 2022 Seniors. Note: We will be painting over any colors on existing spaces that are not "approved" colors before June 5th, 2022. Please look at the spaces ahead of time and be sure to select a space that suits your needs. Students are free to paint over obstacles, blemishes, and the painting of former students. For more information refer to the "Painting Guidelines and Restrictions" section of this packet.

PAINTING GUIDELINES AND RESTRICTIONS

1. This is considered a school spirit enhancement event. To that end, students may only use the following colors: **RED, ROYAL BLUE, WHITE, BLACK, with accents of SILVER metallic.**
2. Students must sketch exactly what they intend to paint in their parking space on the provided form. There may not be any unreasonable variations from what is submitted to what is painted.
3. Students must provide their own paint and all other supplies including rollers, brushes, and painters' tape. Use only outdoor acrylic/latex (water based) paint (in only approved colors). **ABSOLUTELY NO SPRAY PAINT or "CHALK PAINT" ALLOWED.**
4. Paint only in the center of space leaving a 12 inches border from the side white lines and the front and back of the parking space.
5. Prohibited or unapproved designs will be painted over by the administration. Disciplinary action could be taken, and students may forfeit their right to use a senior reserved parking space and/or the privilege to drive/ park on campus.
6. Clean up your painting supplies. Do not splatter or spill paint in any area of the school or parking lot. Bring a trash bag and be prepared to take your trash with you if the MHS trash cans are full.



PROHIBITED:

- No offensive language, images, inferences, pictures, symbols, etc. (At the discretion of the MHS Administration)
- No negative, foul, or rude language.
- No political messages, slogans, or logos.

- No gang style tagging.
- No double meanings.
- No corporate or business advertising.
- Only the Senior's name, monogram or initials can be painted on the parking spot (no boyfriends/girlfriends/friends names allowed)

PAINTING GUIDELINES

- All painting must be done during designated PTA Paint nights or, with the permission of the administration, with a parent's / guardian's in person supervision.
- Students must finish their parking spots before September 5th. After 9-5-2022 painting is prohibited.
- To provide a safe surface for painting and a cooler more productive experience, PTA will hold 2 to 3 paint nights (dates & times TBD) between June 5th and the first day of school.
- Please be aware that our SRO's are aware that Seniors will be painting in the parking lot and local officers will be patrolling the area. MHS security cameras will also be focused and recording all activity in the parking lot. As leaders of the school, Seniors are expected to respect and uphold the restrictions of this sale and the behavior code outlined in the Midway ISD student handbook. Violations of either will result in disciplinary action.
- Parents: Please accompany Seniors when they paint their parking spots.
- Please adhere to all local guidelines for outdoor activities.
- Please park your cars outside of the designated senior sections during paint nights.

TIPS FOR PAINTING

- Bring a broom or brush to clean your space before painting or taping.
- Bring your own lawn trash bag to dispose of your painting items.
- A white primer base coat is suggested to make colors pop and to ensure the paint will last.
- Use only WATER BASED or ACRYLIC/LATEX paint. NO spray paint, oil-based enamels, oil-based primers, or chalk paint can be used in or on the MHS campus.
- Masking tape or painters' tape is helpful to define the borders.
- If ordering stencils, be sure they are parking lot or pavement compatible.
- Split the cost of paint & materials with friends who will painting their spaces at the same time.
- Rollers with long pole handles are best for applying a base coat or large areas of solid paint.
- Bring extra water and paper towels to help clean up after painting.
- Although we are painting in the evening to avoid scorching pavement and heat, it will be warm. We suggest students stay hydrated, wear closed toed shoes (that you do not mind getting paint on,) and bring a towel or a stadium or gardening cushion to kneel or sit on if the pavement is hot.
- Last year's parent/guardian observers brought camp chairs.
- Be respectful of MISD property, other Senior parking spaces and please clean up after yourself.
